

RED CARD SUSPENSION CODES

1 Week Suspension + \$25 Fine

- Game misconduct foul/abusive language
 - Foul language towards referees
 - Foul language towards players/staff/spectators -Leaving penalty/player box to engage in confrontation
- If contact is made, then leaving the penalty box or bench “Violent Conduct”

2 Week Suspension + \$25 Fine

- Violent Conduct
- Violent Conduct towards non-opponent
- Serious foul play -2nd Caution • 3rd Card Received

8 Week Suspension + \$50 Fine

- 1st offense – Fighting 1 on 1, 2 on 2, etc.
- 2nd offense – fighting 1 on 1, 2 on 2, etc.
- Spits at opponent, person or official
- Physical Contact with official

A player who receives a red card must miss the entire week of games regardless of how many teams he/she plays on.

- Repeat offenses can result in longer suspension lengths/fines
- A red card suspension is a facility suspension and applies to ALL teams a player plays on.
- Additional suspension occurs if a player tries to play while being suspended.
- Player and Manager of team will be informed of red cards.
- Suspension period of up to 1 year may occur for 3 red cards within a 1 year period
- All suspension lengths are determined by Game On Management and the decisions are final.

Any player that receives a red card must leave the facility. The game will not start until the player leaves.

Any team that has a player get a red card, will play short a player for the remainder of the game. For CoEd Games, if a male receives a red, the males play down. If a female receives a red, the females play down.
